

Greeley County Farmers' Market Vendor Agreement

I have read and agree to abide by the Greeley County Farmers' Market Operational Guidelines, specifically those items related to Compliance and Vendor Code of Conduct.

All vendors must have a tax schedule and collect taxes or tax exemption certificates from customers during the sale of tangible products. The method of tax collection ("plus tax" or "tax included") is at the discretion of the vendor.

All vendors must obtain a sales tax number from the [Kansas Department of Revenue](#) before being accepted into the market. A new vendor must submit a copy of the certificate with the Vendor Application.

Additionally, vendors MUST comply with ALL applicable local, state, and federal regulations. The vendor must be able to document compliance with laws, regulations, and market bylaws to the Market Manager and/or any customer.

Vendors selling eggs, meat, nursery products, seeds, wine, or processed or prepared foods are required by the state to have special licenses or permits. It is the responsibility of the vendor to have all licenses and permits before selling at the market. If necessary, vendors must provide their own product liability insurance. Vendors should contact the [Kansas Department of Agriculture](#) for additional direction.
