

Greeley County Cemetery Association Rules

As of May 17, 2001

STRICTLY ENFORCED JUNE 15, 2019

Notice is to be given to the cemetery sexton and Register of Deeds office before a burial is done or a headstone is set.

All burials whether traditional or cremains are to be marked, dug and covered by the cemetery sexton.

No individual is to erect monumental work, burial structures or buildings without permission of the cemetery board.

The sexton will direct the placing of any monument on a specified gravesite. The combined width of the monument, foundation and apron will not exceed the width of the grave space on which it is to be placed. Nor should one erect any fence, coping, curbing or enclosure of any kind at the gravesite.

Only monuments or markers of granite, marble, bronze, flush-type grave markers or other permanent materials shall be placed on gravesites. Monuments made of wood, iron, tin, plaster of Paris, cement, limestone, sandstone, artificial stone ARE NOT permitted in the cemetery.

No individual can plant or remove any tree, shrub, flower or other decorative plant. If such becomes detrimental to adjacent lots, walks or streets it may be removed at the discretion of the cemetery board. Planting and care of such will be done by the cemetery sexton and as may be authorized by the cemetery board.

No individual shall disturb or remove any sod, from any part of the cemetery without first having obtained the permission of the cemetery board.

No individual shall apply chemical of any kind to weeds and grass.
