GREELEY COUNTY RECYCLING CENTER

Open for collection 9:00 to 11:00 am, Monday, Thursday, Saturday

Commodities we collect and how to sort and/or prepare them:

Cardboard—corrugated and non-corrugated boxes, brown paper bags; includes feed/seed sacks without a plastic liner. Remove any duct tape that might be on boxes or bags.

Newspaper—includes newsprint with colored inks; phone books with covers removed.

Magazines—includes catalogs, slick-finished papers.

White Paper—good quality white printer paper with any color ink.

Colored Paper—good quality colored printer paper with any color ink.

Junk Mail—includes lesser quality papers, notebook paper, envelopes, paper with "slick" finish, political flyers, NCR paper. NO carbon or construction paper.

Shredded Paper—Please do not bag trash with your shredded paper. Please leave shredded paper in bag you shredded it into. **NO** shredded carbon paper.

Computers—includes CPU's, keyboards, cables, speakers. NO monitors.

Plastics—look for the number in the recycling triangle on the bottom of plastic containers. We take 1's, 2's, and 5's. Labels do not need to be removed. RINSE containers. **NO** lids unless they have a 1, 2, or 5 in the triangle.

Glass—includes any green, brown, blue, clear glass container that held food or drink. Please rinse. Metal lids may be recycled with Tin Cans; check for the recycling number on plastic lids. Labels do not need to be removed. NO light bulbs, window pane, drinking glasses, baking dishes, etc.

Tin Cans—Labels may be removed and recycled in Junk Mail. Please rinse.

Aluminum—Please separate beverage cans from other aluminum. Other aluminum includes cat food cans, pie plates, aluminum foil, phostoxin cans.

Rechargeable Batteries—When rechargeable batteries will no longer recharge, please bring them in so the heavy metals they contain can be re-used.

Miscellaneous—We collect bubble wrap, packing peanuts, and egg cartons. If you need any of these items, please come get them while we are open.

If you have a project and need any of the items we collect, we'd be happy to help you out.

When the wind is bad, or it is really cold, pull up to an east overhead door and honk. When the door opens, please drive in and we will unload you out of the weather.

Duct tape and carbon paper are definite no-no's in the recycling world. Please help us keep them out of the recycling loop.

If you'd like to donate your time some morning, we'd be glad to have more volunteers at the Recycling Center.
